The Lloyd D. Smith Foundation is a non-profit family foundation established to honor the memory and legacy of the late Lloyd D. Smith who was an innovative and highly successful community development leader in Ward Seven and Penn Branch resident. The Foundation primarily provides college scholarships to high school graduates who live in Ward 7. Applicants are evaluated on financial need, grade point average, leadership skills and extracurricular activities. Preference is given to students who wish to pursue a community service related career. Since its inception, the Foundation has awarded nearly \$50,000.00 in scholarships. Most recently, Penn Branch's very own, Rudolf Schreiber, Jr. received a \$2,500 award. The Foundation will be accepting applications during February and March 2017 for students who will be entering college in the fall of 2017. The deadline for receipt of applications is April 16, 2017. If you plan to purchase an outside security camera for your home, you should hurry if you want to qualify for a rebate. Funds will run out soon. The Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants is currently offering rebates of up to

\$200 per camera and \$500 per residence for the purchase and installation of security cameras.
