## Field Reservations Open for Spring Season!

Local sports, community, civic and other groups are encouraged to reserve time at The Fields at RFK Campus for the spring season, which runs March 1 June 20, 2020.

Organizations that offer programming to young people who live within walking distance of The Fields are encouraged to apply. Such organizations may be eligible for the affordable Qualified Community Rate or a fee waiver.

The application window for recurring users (multiple reservations throughout the season) ended on Friday, January 10, 2020, but unscheduled field time may continue to be reserved.

Individuals, families, community and other groups are also encouraged to use the fields for informal sports and recreational activities during Community Open Play times, which are shown on the website calendar. In addition to the turf playing fields, the complex is also home to a playground and shaded picnic area, a celebration pavilion, walking and biking paths, and other amenities.
