

PBCCA Executive Board Proposed 2020 Election Timeline

August 2020

The Penn Branch Citizens Civic Association (PBCCA) Executive Board

- August:
 - The Board will present for community review and input the updated PBCCA Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. Voting Members of PBCCA will have approximately 2 weeks to submit comments and questions.
 - The Board will host an information session and respond to comments and questions. Subsequently, and as needed, it will make changes to the documents in light of feedback from Voting Members of PBCCA.
- September: Voting Members in good standing (who have paid dues no later than September 14) will be given the requisite information for a virtual vote on adoption of the updated Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws.
- October: The Board will report on the work of the Nominating Committee and present 2021 officer nominees.
- November: All Voting Members in good standing will be given the requisite information for a virtual vote to elect officers. Friends of the community who are independent of PBCCA will administer the election of officers and report the results.
 - Assuming the updated By-Laws are adopted, then new officer terms will be staggered to prevent full board turnover at each election, and future elections will take place during every October PBCCA Meeting:
 - Half of the officers (President, Second Vice President, Treasurer, and Communications Director) will serve full 2-year terms
 - The other half (First Vice President, Secretary, and Parliamentarian) will serve a 1-year term in the first cycle and be up for re-election in October 2021
- December: The newly elected Board will be sworn-in and jointly host any end-of-year/holiday event with the outgoing Board.
- January 2021: The newly elected and sworn-in Board will preside over the January 2021 and future PBCCA meetings until their terms expire.
